High Air Temperature 35°C (95°F) or above


- 1. Do not use the choke.
- 2. Open the throttle slightly.
- 3. Start the engine.

Low Air Temperature 10 °C (50 °F) or below

- 1. Follow steps 1-2 under "Normal Air Temperature."
- 2. When engine speed begins to pick up, operate the choke knob to keep fast idle at: 2,500 4,000 min⁻¹ (rpm)
- 3. Continue warming up the engine until it runs smoothly and responds to the throttle when the choke knob (1) is at Fully OFF (B).

CAUTION:

- * Snapping the throttle or fast idling for more than about 5 minutes at normal air temperature may cause exhaust pipe discoloration.
- * Extended use of the choke may impair piston and cylinder wall lubrication.
