Lithium-Ion (Li-Ion) Battery

If you smell an unusual odor coming from the lithium-ion (li-ion) battery, park your motorcycle in a safe place outside and away from flammable objects, then turn the ignition switch to the OFF position. Have your motorcycle inspected by your dealer immediately.

Emergency Shut-down Procedure for Motorcycles Equipped with Dual Clutch Transmission

CRF1000D/D II

Unlike standard motorcycles, or its manual transmission sibling, the CRF1000D and CRF1000D II with dual-clutch transmission does not have a clutch lever that would provide you with an additional means to control the engine power being transmitted to the rear wheel. Thus, in the unlikely event that you experience a stuck throttle or other unintended application of power to the rear wheel, you should shut down the engine by use of the engine stop switch (▶ P. 53). By moving this switch to the (Stop) position, you will immediately stop the engine but maintain all electrical system functions, including lights and indicators.
