




Fig. 4.43 Removing tank side cover

4. To remove the tank side cover 2, remove the two screws on the emblem and then unscrew the side cover bolt. Slide the cover forward to remove. (Fig. 4.43)

5. The fuel cock can be removed by first unscrewing the fuel strainer cap, removing the filter screw and then the cross point fuel cock mounting screw. (1) (Fig. 4.44)

(2) Fuel tank

(C 90, CT 90)

- 1. Turn off the fuel cock, disconnect the fuel line and drain the fuel from the tank.
- 2. Unscrew the tank mounting bolts 1 located at both side of the tank and lift off the tank. (Fig. 4.45)

C. Inspection

- 1. Flush the inside of the tank to remove any scales or other foreign matter.
- 2. Make sure that there are no leaks in the tank.
